NOVICE EVENTS

The novice events are back again and are getting more popular every year. The Novice events are limited to players who have never reached the 2nd round or further in the main events (not plates) of a Tennis Ireland tournament e.g. Larne, Windsor etc. Club tournaments or match plays do not count. Players entering novice events may also enter main events up to the maximum permitted entry of 2 singles, 1 doubles & 1 mixed doubles or 2 singles, 1 main & 1 novice doubles. If you would not be eligible to enter your own age groups novice event you may not enter the next novice age group up.

FINALS DAY

On Saturday 30th July the Finals of all the events (except Under 21s) will be held. There will be a free BBQ for all (players, family, friends & spectators) so come down and enjoy the finals! The presentation of the trophies & other entertainment prizes will start at around 6.30 / 7.00pm. Afterwards everyone is invited to join us for the Finals Night Dinner.

TIEBREAK TOURNAMENT

This event is free and open to all players regardless of age and standard. It will be played on Thursday 28th July. It will be a knockout event with matches being a short tie break. Players will be handicapped based on age, seeding (if any) and events.

PLATES

There will be plates in all events (except no. 27 – 29). So if you enter 2 events you are guaranteed a minimum of 4 matches. Plate events usually involve shorter matches but with a full 3 set final and have a small prize for the winner and runner up.

ENTERTAINMENT

Once again we have got a full week of action off the court as well as on it! The daytime entertainment will normally start around 2pm and the evening events about 7.30pm. Keep an eye on the website for more information!

UNDER 21s

The Under 21 events are for everyone who left the junior tournaments in the last couple of years. There is a lower as well as upper age limit for the Under 21 events. Players entering must be 16 or over on 31st December 2010. These events will take place from Sunday 24th July with play commencing each day at 5.30pm. The finals will take place on Friday.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- The tournament is sanctioned by the Council of Tennis Ireland and will be conducted under the Rules of Lawn Tennis and the Regulations of Tennis Ireland. Entrants shall abide by the rules of Belfast Boat Club. Full details are available on request.
- Entries will close on Tuesday 19th July 2011.
- Persons entering must be under the stipulated age on 31st December 2010.
- The winners of events 1 – 14 & 25-29 are solely responsible for the trophy presented for their event. They must be returned or the full replacement cost paid no less than 1 week before the start of the tournament next year.
- Subject to the discretion of the tournament referee a competitor not available for play when required will be scratched. Competitors should not leave the club grounds without first informing the tournament referee.
- In all matters the decision of the tournament referee will be final.**
- Players must be available to play on Finals day (Saturday 30th July 2011) if required except if entering mini/midi or Under 21 events.
- Play will commence at 8.00am each day and will if necessary continue until 11pm.
- By entering the tournament you give permission for your son/daughter to be photographed and/or filmed by or on behalf of the committee for promotional purposes.**
- ORDER OF PLAY:** The order of play will be available on the tournament website, www.ulster-junior-open.org from 9.30pm each evening. It will also be available by phoning the Boat Club between 10.00pm and 10.30pm each night on 9066 5012. It is the responsibility of competitors to acquaint themselves with their time of play each day.
- A restringing service will be provided throughout the tournament.
